THE WINE

The Everton Red Shiraz is harvested from a combination of vineyards throughout South Australia. This Shiraz has a vibrant purple colour with magenta hue. The nose has plum and mocca notes while the palate is medium bodies with juicy dark fruit flavours and a gentle black pepper spice. The wine is supple and balanced on the finish and should be consumed in the first 4 years from vintage.

THE GRAPE VARIETY

Shiraz, the Australian name for the Syrah grape, is one of the oldest known grape varieties. Shiraz is responsible for many of the Rhone Valley's best known and highly acclaimed red wines. It has also made itself very much at home within the wide range of soils and climates of Australia's diverse viticultural regions. Although once considered the 'workhorse' of the Australian wine industry, shiraz is now treasured and revered for the wonderful, generously flavoured wines it produces and its distinctive rich, berry flavours and silky tannins.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

The grapes for this wine were grown at a number of sites throughout South Australia. The fruit was harvested from late February to early April at a range of baumé levels from 13 to 14.5. To keep this wine youthful and vibrant in fruit intensity it was not stored in oak barrels. The wine was bottled with an alcohol of 14.5%.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

The Everton Shiraz is a medium bodied style and would be perfect with an array of meat dishes like roasted rare lamb cutlets served on kipfler potatoes and a rocket salad. Why not try it with flat iron steak and a black pepper red wine jus.
