

## Being quality our main focus we are certified by most recognized International Certification Bodies:
















All of our production is manufactured in Finale Emilia with total control over raw materials.

ORIGIN: Italy ABV: 28%

PRODUCTION METHOD: cold extraction with hydro-

**INGREDIENTS**: water, sugar, alcohol, glucose syrup,
